

BEAUTIFICATION GRANT PROGRAM

The Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT's) **Beautification Grant Program** aims to enhance the attractiveness of landscapes and facilities on the State Transportation System. Projects are typically installed on FDOT Right-of-Ways but can extend into publicly owned properties that are contiguous and visible from the FDOT Right-of-Way. This is a **reimbursement grant**, meaning projects must be completed before grantees receive funds.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- This year grants may be eligible for up to \$200,000
- **Eligible Applicants:** Local Governments (Cities, Counties, Municipalities)
- **Eligible Projects:** Purchase and installation of plant materials, soil amendments, and irrigation systems; site preparation (including removal of invasive species, dead trees, etc.)
- There is no limitation on the number of applications that eligible applicants can submit!
- **Applicants should work closely with their [District Grant Coordinator](#) throughout the application process.** To receive funding, your application should include a letter of authorization from your District Grant Coordinator to verify the proposed project does not conflict with other FDOT programs or activities. Draft Grant Applications are due to the District Grant Coordinator for review on **August 14, 2023** at 5:00 p.m. ET.
