

CONTROL OF THE WORK.

(REV 1-9-01) (7-01)

SUBARTICLE 5-1.1 (Page 26) is expanded as follows:

All reference to separate payment for individual items of work shall not apply. The cost for various items of work shall be included and paid for under the Contract Lump Sum Price.

SUBARTICLE 5-1.4.2 (Pages 28 and 29) is deleted and the following substituted:

5-1.4.2 Work Items Requiring Shop Drawings: Review the Contract Documents to determine the submittals required.

The following signing and lighting items are structural items that require shop drawings:

- (a) Lighting: Poles, bracket arms, frangible bases, and foundations.
- (b) Signing: Mounting brackets for bridge-mounted signs, overhead cantilever structures, overhead truss structures, overhead sequential sign structures, and multiple post sign supports, along with applicable foundations.

In general, the Department requires shop drawings for:

- (a) Bridge, bulkhead and retaining wall structures, cofferdams, and lighting and signing structural items, along with the applicable foundations.
- (b) Signing, lighting, drainage structures, attenuators, and other nonstructural items.

- (c) Building structures.
- (d) Contractor-originated re-design.
- (e) Design and structural details furnished by the Contractor in compliance with the Contract.

- (f) Special erection equipment.
- (g) Falsework and shoring.

Additional clarification for certain types of bridge structures is provided in 5-1.4.9.

ARTICLE 5-2 (Page 35). The first paragraph is deleted and the following substituted:

These Specifications, the plans, Special Provisions, and all supplementary documents are integral parts of the Contract; a requirement occurring in one is as binding as though occurring in all. In addition to the work and materials specifically called for in the Contract Documents and any additional incidental work, not specifically mentioned, when so shown in the plans, or if indicated, or obvious and apparent, as being necessary for the proper completion of the work will be included in the Contract Lump Sum Price.

SUBARTICLE 5-7.6 (Page 38) is deleted.
