

102-8.6 Temporary Vehicular Impact Attenuator.

(REV 4-26-96) (FA 5-29-96) (7-02)

Make necessary repairs due to defective material, work, or Contractor operations at no cost to the Department.

Restore attenuators damaged by the traveling public after the installation is completed and accepted within 24 hours. Restoration of the attenuator will be paid for at the invoice price plus 20%, for the new parts authorized by the Engineer. Payment for restoration will be full compensation for all necessary work and materials.

Delineate the attenuators with a Type I object marker, as specified in Section 705.

Payment will be made for each location, including object marker. Price and payment will be full compensation for furnishing, installing, maintaining and subsequently removing such attenuators. After removal, take ownership of the attenuator.
