LIMITATIONS OF OPERATIONS – FENCING.
(REV 2-4-03)

SUBARTICLE 8-4.8 (Page 76) is deleted and the following substituted:

8-4.8 Fencing: Erect permanent fence as a first order of business on all projects that include fencing where the Engineer determines that the fencing is necessary to maintain the security of livestock on adjacent property, or for protection of pedestrians who are likely to gain access to the project from adjacent property. *Secure the right-of-way on Limited Access Facilities at all times by a fence, either temporary or permanent.*

8-4.8 Fencing: Erect permanent fence as a first order of business on all projects that include fencing where the Engineer determines that the fencing is necessary to maintain the security of livestock on adjacent property, or for protection of pedestrians who are likely to gain access to the project from adjacent property.

550-4 Construction Methods.

550-4.1 General

550-4.1.1 New or Replacement Fence: Install the fence in accordance with the specific requirements of this Article and with the details shown on the Roadway and Traffic Design Standards for the particular type of fence called for, except for Type R Fence which shall be detailed in the plans. Construct the fence in close proximity to the right of way line except as may be detailed otherwise in the plans. Assume responsibility for obtaining satisfactory permits or permission from property owners for any encroachments required to perform the work, and for proper scheduling of the fence installation with the removal of existing fence where it is necessary to provide continuous security to adjacent areas already fenced. In order to meet this requirement, where necessary for maintaining security of livestock on adjacent property during construction of the new fence, the Engineer may require the erection and subsequent removal of temporary fencing. *Secure the Right-of-Way on Limited Access Facilities at all times by a fence, either temporary or permanent.*

550-4.1.2 Temporary fencing: *Erection and subsequent removal of temporary fencing may be necessary for maintaining security of the adjacent property during construction as directed by the Engineer or shown in the plans. Secure the ROW on all Limited Access Facilities at all times.*
