**JACK AND BORE-BASIS OF PAYMENT.
(REV 1-9-03)**

ARTICLE 556-8 (of the Supplemental Specifications) is deleted and the following substituted:

556-8 Basis of Payment.

*Price and P*payment will be full compensation for all work *and all materials required to complete the work* specified in this Section, including *furnishing and installing casings*~~all installations~~, from plan point of beginning to plan point of ending (~~i.e. pull box~~) at plan depth, removal of excavated materials and spoils, removal and disposal of drilling fluids, backfilling, and complete restoration of the site.

The installation of tracking conductors (wire or tape) will be included in the cost of the bore and will not be paid for separately.

No payment will be made for failed bore paths, injection of excavatable flowable fill, products taken out of service or incomplete installations.

No payment will be made for jack and bore until a Bore Path Report has been delivered to the Engineer. After the Engineer's acceptance of the Bore Path Report, payment will be made in the amount of 70% of the unit price bid, for Jack and Bore. The remaining 30% of the unit price bid will be made after submittal of As-Built Plans, in accordance with 556-6.2.

Bob,

It appears that your only problem with 556 is that it does not include the word "furnish" as a requirement along with installation of the casing.

The Drainage Office agrees that there is a potential for mis-use if there are any (gasp) devious contractors in the State, and suggests that the first sentence in 556-8 could be changed to read:

"Price and payment will be full compensation for all work and all materials required to complete the work specified in this Section, including furnishing and installing casing from plan point of beginning to plan point of ending at plan depth, removal of excavated materials and spoils, removal and disposal of drilling fluids, backfilling, and complete restoration of the site."

No other change to the specification is recommended.
