Use only Department approved signal inspection report forms during the signal inspection activities. Ensure all equipment, materials, and hardware are in compliance with Department Specifications and verify that all equipment requiring certification is listed on the Department's Approved Product List (APL). Provide the completed signal inspection report form(s), certified by the IMSA Traffic Signal Inspector to the Engineer.~~
