

**DISCHARGE TO OR WORK OR STRUCTURES IN NAVIGABLE WATERS OF THE U.S., WATERS OF THE U.S., AND WATERS OF THE STATE.  
(REV 2-21-01) (7-02)**

SUBARTICLE 7-2.2 (Page 58) is expanded by the following:

The Federal permit titled “Final Modification of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit for Storm Water Discharges From Construction Activities” applies to this Contract. Obtain a copy of the permit through the Department’s website and comply with the requirements of the permit. The URL for obtaining a copy of the permit is [www11.myflorida.com/specificationsoffice/npdes2000.pdf](http://www11.myflorida.com/specificationsoffice/npdes2000.pdf) . The Federal NPDES permit requires that inspections be performed by qualified personnel who have completed the Florida Storm Water, Erosion and Sediment Control Training and Certification Program for Inspectors and Contractors and who have passed the examination.

The State permit titled “Stormwater Discharge from Construction Activities That Disturb Five or More Acres of Land” applies to this Contract. Obtain a copy of the permit through the Department’s website and comply with the requirements of the permit. The Contractor is responsible for all inspection requirements of the Federal and/or State NPDES permits. Use the inspection form provided by the Engineer to report all inspection findings and to document all corrective actions taken as a result of the inspection. Sign each inspection report and submit it weekly to the Engineer.
