SUBARTICLE 102-9.3 (Page 107). The second paragraph is deleted and the following substituted:

Use signs ~~meeting the requirements of Index 17355 unless~~ *with* specific business names signs are requested and approved by the Engineer. ~~In those cases, show specific business names on~~ *on* each sign. Install logos provided by business owners and approved by the Engineer. *Standard Business entrance signs meeting the requirements of Index 17355 without specific business names may be used only with the approval of the Engineer.*

SUBARTICLE 102-9.3 (Page 107). The second paragraph is deleted and the following substituted:
