**UNFIT, HAZARDOUS, AND DANGEROUS MATERIALS
(REV 6-24-05)**

SUBARTICLE 6-12.3 (of the Supplemental Specifications) is deleted and the following substituted:

6-12.3 Unfit, Hazardous, and Dangerous Materials: Do not use any material that, after approval and/or placement, has in any way become unfit for use. Do not use materials containing any substance that has been determined to be hazardous by the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection or the U.S. Department of Environmental Protection. *Do not use asbestos containing materials.* Provide workplaces free from serious recognized hazards and to comply with occupational safety and health standards, as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor Occupational Safety and Health Administration.
