Permits on both private & public work are generally considered to be the responsibility of the owner. Possible conflicts with different government agencies with which the contractor has no influence as an agent to the customer. The ambiguity of whose jurisdiction this specification falls under serves as a limitation to the contractor for bidding purposes from project to project.

Response: Revised to delete permit from this sentence since permitting requirements covered elsewhere and investigation indicates no permit required now for this.
