Comments:

1. Use a more generalized statement, as written in the 5560301 Jack & Bore Spec.556-3.1b, "...eliminate the 'designed' use of..." instead of "...expose utilities through..." so that this statement includes any type of disruption to the use of the sidewalks.

Response: The requested simplified language of 5560301 was used with one change to address your comment on clarification of "use." I deleted the words "eliminate the" and added "disrupt pedestrian." in its place.

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Comments:

Included the word "designed" prior to the word "use" (or some similar word) in Section 556-3.1b so that the Contractor may not loosely interpret the word "use."
