KEEP THE ENGINEER OF RECORD TERMINOLOGY- THE ENGINEER DOES NOT WANT TO BE THE MIDDLE MAN FOR THE SIGN SUBMITTALS- Submit seven copies of shop drawings indicating detailed layout of the sign legend, spacing, and border for all other signs to the Engineer of Record prior to fabrication.

Response: This entire sentence is out of place. Shop drawing submittals are covered in Section 5. The number of copies and the submittal path are included in Section 5 so this sentence is in conflict. My recommendation is to have the folks responsible for signs to rewrite this paragraph to coordinate with Section 5.

For now, leave the Engineer of Record in this section as this is where Section 5 states to send shop drawings.
