Make all requests for payment by submitting these certifications no later than 12:00 noon on the Monday following the estimate cut-off date or as directed by the Engineer, based on the amount of work done or completed.

Certification of Quantities – In some cases, the “Certification” forms are delivered to the CEI late on Monday afternoon. This coupled with the fact the FDOT requires the CEI to submit the progress estimate on the Monday following Cut Off, puts tremendous pressure on the CEI to simply accept the contractor’s quantities.

I would like to see the second paragraph of 711-9.2 to include the following statement: “Make all requests for payment by submitting these certifications no later than Twelve O’clock noon Monday after the estimate cut-off. *Request received after Twelve O’clock Noon will be process on the following month’s estimate.*”

In this change it states that a certification of quantities is required "for each project in the contract". This is contradicting what the contractors have been told to do for multiple projects. With this change they will have to keep quantities separate on multi-project contracts.

711-9.2 Certification of Quantities Submittal Instructions: Prepare a certification of quantities, using the Department's current approved form, for each project in the Contract. Submit the certification of quantities and daily worksheets to the Engineer.
