For consistency should it not be like

Example:

Reflector Elements*Section 993
**Qualified Products List (QPL) item(s)*

For consistency should it not be like this: (IN BLUE)

Portland Cement ConcreteSection 346
Reinforcing SteelSection 415
Joint Materials Section 932-1.1
Joint Materials Section 932-1.2 and 932-1.3*
Reflector Elements*Section 993
**Qualified Products List (QPL) item(s)*

Response: “Section” is used when reference is made to the entire section of the book (Section 346, Section 400, etc.). When an article is referenced only the numbers are used (346-1.1, 400-10, etc.). The word “Section” will be removed from Joint Materials since this now references article 932-1.1.
