This is one of several specifications to be implemented as special provisions to be used on Streamline Contracts, defined as projects less than \$2,000,000 and less than 2,000 tons of asphalt. This change was proposed by the State Specifications Office to ensure reporting requirements defined in the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 are met when a Streamline Contract, both lump sum and plan quantity, is funded by the ARRA of 2009.
