Comments: (6-28-10) If we are removing the 972 reference from the above section, would it help to add "800 Section" at the end of the expression so it reads, "meet the requirements of the Design Standards 800 Section", for a quick reference.<<>> If all the requirements that are pertinent to the plastic fence post, that were in Section 972 are covered in the Design Standard Index 801, the proposed change is ok.<<>> If this product will no longer be required to be listed on the QPL, will we in the future accept the product base on certification from the manufacturer, or as long as it meets the requirements of the Design Standard?
