Problem statement: Current specifications require contract administrators track payment for individual pay items associated with directional bores, jack & bores, vibratory plowing and signalization items and withhold payment of those individual items until as-built plans, bore path reports and plowing path reports are submitted.

Proposed solution: Require that final payment in accordance with 9-8 be withheld until all as-built plans, bore path reports and plowing path reports are submitted by the contractor and accepted by the department.

SUBARTICLE 611-2.3.3 (Page 732) is deleted and the following substituted:

611-2.3.3 Compensation: All costs involved with providing as-built *drawings* plans are incidental to the other items of work associated with traffic control signals and devices. ~~Payment for the work associated with traffic control signals and devices will be made at 85% of the unit price bid for the installation. The remaining 15% of the unit price will be made after submittal and acceptance of the As-Built Plans~~ *Final payment is contingent upon submittal and Department acceptance of the as-built drawings.*
