Comment: (11-3-10)

Suggest adding the following paragraph and change (underlined):

No contractor or his or her affiliate, as set forth in Section 337.165 F.S., shall be qualified to bid on work let by the Department when it is determined by the Department that he or she has, subsequent to January 1, 1978, been convicted of a contact crime within the jurisdiction of any state or federal court.

In addition, [a] A person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit the following:

- (a) A bid on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity.
- (b) A bid on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work.
- (c) Bids on leases of real property to a public entity.

Response: Upon further review of Article 2-1, Florida Statutes, and Florida Administrative Code, the requirements in the specification are already addressed by statute or rule and don't need to be repeated. The language has been replaced with a sentence requiring bidders to prequalify in accordance with Florida Statute and Rule.
