As a rule, measurements, ages, etc. included in written text should be depicted as numbers if they are 10 or greater, but should be spelled if they are less than 10.

Response:

From the Specifications Office:

As a general rule, we spell out the words for numbers "one thru ten" unless it is followed by a unit of measurement or is truly intended as a quantity (e.g., 5 feet, 30 calendar days).

When numbers are used to define both quantity and size, use the written word for the quantity and numerals for the size (e.g.: one 4 foot gate).
