SUBARTICLE 611-4 (e) (Page 734) is deleted and the following substituted:

(e) Start the 48 hour test on a Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday. ~~However, do not start the 48 hour test on the day preceding a holiday at a date and time to allow continuous operation of the traffic signal system for a 48 hour period~~ *Ensure the 48 hour test does not include weekends, Holidays, or Special Events.*

SUBARTICLE 611-4 (e) (Page 734) is deleted and the following substituted:
