**CONTRACTOR QUALITY CONTROL GENERAL REQUIREMENTS.
(REV 12-2-11)**

SUBARTICLE 105-8.6.2 (of the Supplemental Specifications) is deleted and the following substituted:

105-8.6.2 Paving Technicians: For paving operations (*with the exception of miscellaneous or temporary asphalt*), keep a qualified CTQP Asphalt Paving Level II technician on the roadway at all times when placing asphalt mix for the Department, and perform all testing with a CTQP Asphalt Paving Level I technician. As an exception, measurements of cross-slope, temperature, and yield (spread rate), ~~as well as the inspection of the placement of miscellaneous asphalt,~~ can be performed by someone under the supervision of a CTQP Paving Level II technician.

Comment [r1]: This change makes the specification compliant with expired Construction Memorandum 17-04. The memorandum changes were mistakenly not incorporated into the specification.
