Comments: (3-8-12) I recommend that you insert "steel" in front of offset blocks, too when referring to steel offset blocks. There are at least three locations, i.e. steel posts and steel offset blocks in 536-2.2.3 (two locations) and in 536-2.6 (one location).

Comments: (3-20-12) **1) 536-2.2.3 Steel Posts and Steel Offset Blocks:** Use steel posts and steel offset blocks meeting the requirements of ASTM A36 steel. **2) 536-2.6 For steel rail and steel rail elements, provide the Engineer with a certified mill analysis from the manufacturer meeting the requirements of Section 967. For steel posts and steel offset blocks furnish the Engineer a certified mill analysis**
