SUBARTICLE 902-1.1 (Page 819) is deleted and the following substituted:

**902-1.1 Composition:** Fine aggregate shall consist of natural silica sand, screenings, local materials, or subject to approval, other inert materials with similar characteristics, or combination thereof, having hard, strong, durable particles, conforming to the specific requirements of this Section.

Approval of ~~mineral~~ *construction*<sub>[d1]</sub> aggregate sources shall be in accordance with 6-3.3.

SUBARTICLE 902-3.2 (Page 820) is deleted and the following substituted:

**902-3.2 Brick Masonry:** Sand for brick masonry shall meet the quality requirements of 902-2, except for gradation requirements. All the materials shall pass the No. 8 sieve, and be ~~uniformly~~ *well*<sub>[d2]</sub> graded from coarse to fine.
