## CLEARING AND GRUBBING. (REV 12-11-13)

SUBARTICLE 110-11.3 is deleted and the following substituted:

**110-11.3 Removal of Existing Pavement:** Payment for removal of flexible asphalt pavement is included in the Lump Sum price for Clearing and Grubbing.

When a separate item for Removal of Existing Pavement is provided, No separate payment will be made for removal of curb or sidewalk that is removed and replaced, as specified in 520-11 and 522-9.

\$\pm\$The quantity to be paid for will be the number of square yards of existing pavement of the types listed in 110-7, acceptably removed and disposed of, as specified. The quantity will be determined by actual measurement along the surface of the pavement before its removal. Measurements for appurtenances which have irregular surface configurations, such as curb and gutter, steps, and ditch pavement, will be the area as projected to an approximate horizontal plane. Where the removal of pavement areas is necessary only for the construction of box culverts, pipe culverts, storm sewers, inlets, manholes, etc., these areas will not be included in the measurements.
