1. 990-6.1(2) "and inert to all normal atmospheric conditions and temperature ranges found in Florida." – This language is too vague and should be removed or defined.

Response: This comment is beyond the scope of this change and will be considered for future revisions of this section. No change made.

2. 990-6.1(4) "For glare screen mounted on temporary barrier wall, a strip (minimum 3 inch width and minimum 72 square inches) of reflective sheeting as specified in 994 2 shall be placed on a panel,..." – To meet them minimum square inches, the reflective sheeting must be placed vertically on the panel. This should be stated 'shall be placed vertically on the panel'.

Response: "Shall" has been changed to "must". Panel size would typically only accommodate vertical placement of reflective sheeting. No change made.

3. . 990-6.1(5) "Prior to approval an impact test shall be performed by the manufacturer to verify the safety performance of the proposed system." – Suggest 'The manufacturer will perform an impact test.'

4. Alternative designs for temporary glare screen may be submitted as a Cost Savings Initiative Proposal in accordance with 4 3.9. – This language should be removed.
