9-8.1 (9): The Contractor has furnished all required manufacturers' warranties to the Engineer. - Is there any different in getting manufactures' warranties in 120 days (30 days to prepare the offer letter and 90 days contractor's response to the offer) from final acceptance that getting first the (Section 608) "Transfer warranties upon final acceptance in accordance with 5-11. Document all warranties and warranty transfers and provide a copy to the Engineer." . Need clarification if the warranties will be provided at final acceptance or within 120 days from final acceptance. - How do we know (DFEO) how many warranties it is expected. - Who will review for document completion and acceptable by the Department. - In my opinion, we do not have control of this item and therefore, it will affect district goals.

Response: The manufacturers' warranties are required upon final acceptance. If these warranties are not received within 90 days of the Department's offer of final payment, then the Department can suspend the Certificate of Qualification. Listing this in 9-8.1 helps ensure that we get the warranties.
