

## **AWARD AND EXECUTION OF CONTRACT (BID FACTOR).**

**(REV 1-23-14) (1-17)**

ARTICLE 3-1. The first paragraph is expanded by the following:

The quantities shown on the Bid Price Proposal are approximate and only represent estimated planned requirements based on historical or specific project needs.

The Department does not guarantee any maximum or minimum quantity, any range of quantities, or the exact quantities shown for each bid item. Use the Department's quantities and prices listed for each item in the Bid Price Proposal to determine a bid factor. The bid factor will be used to determine the low bidder; however, actual payment under the awarded contract will be based on actual quantities completed.

In the event of any discrepancy in the three entries for the price for any item, the Department will evaluate the bid based on the unit price as shown in words unless the extension and the unit price shown in figures are in agreement with each other, in which case, the Department will evaluate the bid based on the amounts in agreement over the unit price shown in words.
