TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE MATERIALS: What is a "vehicular longitudinal channelizing device"? Is it the same as a "pedestrian longitudinal channelizing device"? These should be clearly defined and identified as to when/where each may be used and not-used. I.e., 'pedestrian' longitudinal channelizing devices' should not be used as 'vehicular' longitudinal channelizing devices'.

Response:

Vehicular LCDs are devices used to guide vehicular traffic through and around work zones, whereas Pedestrian LCDs are devices used to guide pedestrians through and around work zones. More information on the use of these devices can be found in the MUTCD Section 6F.63, Specification 102-9 and the Standard Plans, Index 102-600 and 102-660.
