They are the ideal individuals to do this as they will likely have the most expertise and are specifically trained to be able to identify tree species and determine grade and evaluate the overall health of the tree.

section 580-2.1.2 paragraph 4 last sentence. Instead of Engineer it should say Registered Landscape Architect / Professional of Record. The landscape architect is the Professional with the knowledge of the plant material and the one signing for the proposed landscape plans. If no Landscape Architect is assigned to the project the "/ Professional of Record" i.e. the engineer is still covered.
