COMMENT: Actuation signs are not currently accepted as a separate product. They should be fabricated in accordance with Section 700 (sheeting and panel). There are no manufacturer's instructions for installation; these requirements are also in Section 700. Please consider an update to materials article from Section 994 (sheeting only) to Section 700 (complete sign panel=sheeting + aluminum).

**RESPONSE:** Per follow-up discussions, the recommended changes to reference Section 700 have been incorporated in the latest draft. The draft still includes the reference to manufacturers' instructions for installation since these sign panels may also be incorporated into the housing of certain pedestrian detector assemblies. For example, they may be directly attached and provided as part of an approved accessible detector assembly.

**ACTION TAKEN:** The material reference in 665-2 has been updated to point to Section 700 rather than Section 994 such that it covers the complete static sign panel as recommended.
