COMMENT: 110-10.3, fourth sentence: The word "allow" should not be capitalized (it's the second of two statements strung together with a semi-colon). 110-10.3, sixth sentence: Recommend removing the phrase "at locations provided by the Contractor". Believed to be covered by Spec 4-5.1 Ownership and Disposal of Existing Materials, 4-6 Final Cleaning up of Right-of-Way, Spec 110-8 Clearing and Grubbing, Ownership of Materials, Spec 110-9 Clearing and Grubbing, Disposal of Materials, Spec 120-5 Disposal of Surplus and Unsuitable Material, Spec 125-12 Excavation for Structures and Pipe, Cleaning Up, et.al., as well as Federal and State Statutes. 110-11.6: Why are we paying for reused mailboxes? Why are we relocating mailboxes to the same address? 110-12.6, first sentence: Recommend removing the phrase "removal and disposition of existing mailbox". Believed to be covered by Spec 4-5.1 Ownership and Disposal of Existing Materials, 4-6 Final Cleaning up of Right-of-Way, Spec 110-8 Clearing and Grubbing, Ownership of Materials, Spec 110-9 Clearing and Grubbing, Disposal of Materials, Spec 120-5 Disposal of Surplus and Unsuitable Material, Spec 125-12 Excavation for Structures and Pipe, Cleaning Up, et.al., as well as Federal and State Statutes.

110-10.3 -- Agreed.

110-10.3, 6<sup>th</sup> sentence – Agreed.

110-11.6 – Reuse would need to be approved by the Engineer. We would be paying for the work involved. Relocating may be necessary due to widening and offset requirements. We anticipate this would be rare, and only in cases where the Postal Customer strongly objects/loses value with a standard replacement.

110-12.6 – “Disposition” in this instance is meant to “indicate the final arrangement of the existing boxes (whether reused/relocated, not just discarded).
