

D6 MAJOR PROJECTS


- SR 826/Palmetto Expressway From US-I/SR 5/Dixie Highway to SR 836/Dolphin Expressway (432639-I)
 - Provides continuous express lanes along SR 826 and connects with
 I-75 and I-95 Express Lanes. Est. Construction Cost: \$656 million.
- SR 826/Palmetto Expressway Managed Lanes From I-75 to west of NW 17 Avenue. (435760-1,2,3,4,5,6)
 - Provide continuity with the proposed express lanes on SR 826 as envisioned in the emerging South Florida Express Lanes network.
 Est. Construction Cost: \$627 million.





D6 MAJOR PROJECTS (CONTINUED)

- US-27/SR 25/Okeechobee Road (423251-5)
 - Full reconstruction to provide concrete pavement, grade separation, creation of a new bridge at NW 116 Way, widening of bridge at NW 121 Ave. and replacement of bridge across the Miami Canal at NW 116 Way. Est. Construction Cost: \$49.4 million.





D6 MAJOR PROJECTS (CONTINUED)

- Miami-Dade Express Double Diamond Interchange (DDI) SR 836/Dolphin Expressway at NW 27 Avenue and NW 57th Avenue
 - The Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) improves the flow of traffic entering and exiting the SR 836/Dolphin Expressway. Both DDI's are currently completed and operational.


