

VEHICLE FLUID



SPILL MITIGATION GUIDELINES

- Identify spill as a vehicle fluid, *not* cargo
- Stop leaking fluid at the source
- Contain and limit spill from spreading
- Apply available **absorbent** (can use sand or dirt if needed)
 - Sweep material off travel lanes
 - Apply second application, if necessary
- Gradually **restore** traffic flow
- Ensure proper **notifications** are made
 - Identify responsible party
 - Mark location of material

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IDENTIFY REPORTABLE QUANTITY

- 25+ gallons for spilled petroleum products spilled on land
- Any amount which causes sheen on navigable waters
- If in doubt, report to **State Watch Office** at 800-320-0519 (24/7)
- Be prepared to provide the following info: location, type of fluid spilled, responsible party name, address, & phone number

All of these actions should be based on responder's level of training, use of the appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), and following relevant Maintenance of Traffic Guidelines



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
