1. Report Name:

DMS Messages

2. Purpose of the Report:

To provide district management the ability to review the message history for DMS signs.

3. Report Field Definition:

Below are definitions of the primary report fields used and displayed in the report sections.

DMS NAME: The display name of the DMS in SunGuide

DATE CREATED: The timestamp that the message was posted on the DMS.

DATE ENDED: The timestamp that the message was removed from the DMS.

MESSAGE TEXT PG1: The formatted message data for the first phase.

MESSAGE TEXT PG2: The formatted message data for the second phase.

MESSAGE TEXT PG3: The formatted message data for the third phase.

OWNER: The user (or subsystem) that created the message.

EVENT ID: The linked event's ID (if the DMS message was posted from a response plan).

4. Inclusion Criteria:

The message must be successfully posted to DMS in order to appear in the report.

5. Database Tables and Fields:

The data in this report comes from the following tables and their associated fields.

DMS

DMS_IDENTIFIER: The display name of the DMS in SunGuide.

ODS_DMS_MESSAGES

DATE_CREATED: The timestamp that the message was posted on the DMS.

DATE_ENDED: The timestamp that the message was removed from the DMS.

MESSAGE_TEXT: The message data for all phases including the formatting markup.

OWNER: The user (or subsystem) that created the message.

EVENT_ID: The unique identifier of the associated event (if it exists).
