

Confirmation Popup



- System will send a popup to user to remind them of an upcoming planned event
 - Configurable number minutes before the event
- Options for user to resolve to popup
 - Start Now
 - Start Now and activate response plan
 - Start at scheduled time
 - Start at scheduled time and activate response plan
 - Reschedule
 - Void the event
- What should be done if no user responds?

Other Considerations

- Performance Measures
 - “Created Date” of the event would remain the time the event became Active, not the time the initial planned event was created.
 - Blockage times would also need to be moved to the start time of the event, not the time they were set in the planned event
- Nightly Blockage
 - If the event is scheduled but needs to turn on/off the response plan manually:
 - Use the existing SAS response plan scheduling for activation of response plan on an open event
 - Alternately, this could be a series of single nightly planned events?
 - Are metrics for construction closures tracked where the information would be needed in a single event?



Other Considerations

- Rescheduling an existing event
 - Scenario – Operator works the event, has a specific response plan but will needs this again in the near future
 - Potentially, have a ribbon button to create a planned event from the existing
 - Clone event but would maintain response plans and lane blockage.
