
#### **Current Behavior**



#### **Current Behavior**


- Crashes caused by a wrong way driver can be reported two ways:
  - A Wrong Way Driver event is cloned into secondary Crash event
  - A Crash event is determined after the fact to have been caused by a Wrong Way Driver
- We need to be able to track Crashes caused by wrong way drivers regardless of how they were reported.





#### **Proposed Change**


• Add a new Event Type descriptor



 If a WWD event is cloned into a Crash then the WWD descriptor will be set automatically.

- All process are currently compiled under .NET 4.0
- That is a minimum version that needs to be installed and works with higher version of .NET if installed on the machine.
- This has not been updated as there were still installations using Server 2003 and XP

#### **Proposed Change**



- There is a need to upgrade .NET version to take advantages of libraries for device integrations.
- Due to recent upgrades, we believe the new minimums are Server 2008R2 and Windows 7
  - What are the current lowest supported versions?



### **Proposed Change**



- If Server 2008R2 and Windows 7 (or Windows 10 without April or October 2018 Update)
  - .NET 4.6 will be the highest possible
- If Server 2008R2 SP1 and Windows 7 (or Windows 10 assuming current)
  - .NET 4.7.2 (current .NET version)
