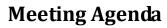

# **Roll Call**

## Action items review

• SSUG to provide input/priority of FP 1748 (reuse name in other agency) and FP 1634 (same issue with contact phone number) (unassigned - ran out of time last meeting) (Clay emailed about these issues on 11/22/2011 – they are possibly covered by Database ID's enhancement approved at CMB on 11/15);

**AI: Clay will get cost requested for 1634** – (**this is now already done (requested**)) Cost estimate was requested again on 1/26/2012 to be provided prior to CMB in February

## **Current Topics:**

- John CMB Update
- C2C discussion feedback from users possible enhancement/ ideas to improve robustness. Mark: restarts every day, sometimes multiple times per day; connected to FL-ATIS, D4, and MDX. FL-ATIS restarts happens the most.

D2 only connected to FL-ATIS, connections issues, but hard to tell if it's local or on FL-ATIS side. Restarting web services usually clears things up.

D1 is not having any issues with C2C, they are connected to FL-ATIS and Lee County. D2 has his C2C web services (IIS application pools) auto-restarted twice daily 10am & 10pm. Neena said FL-ATIS and D4 auto-recycles as well.

D5 has same problem, if you restart subsystem, they do not populate to FL-ATIS until you restart C2C – quite frequently – end up taking down OOCEA TVT, DMS, or all devices. Doesn't sync back up until we restart C2C, and causes problems with floodgates. Restarting web services in IIS will take down floodgates then requires additional restarts until floodgates work.
