Current Topics

- C2C Reliability
 - Restarts are frequent throughout the state, more so in some districts than others
 - Open C2C Tickets
 - **FP 2209:** TvT Reporting Zero Speeds when Valid TSS Provided via C2C – SwRI provided a patch for OOCEA and issue appears to be resolved
 - **FP 2167:** C2C Disconnect Handling – Enhancement to not purge all data upon momentary disconnection. SwRI investigating.
 - **FP 2121:** Chronic C2C Disconnections – SwRI provided a patch for OOCEA and issues appear to be resolved
 - **FP 2073:** Generate TSS-like alerts from C2C data sources – May be a large effort to implement. SwRI investigating.
 - **FP 2047:** C2C Provider does not receive networkData – Work around is in place for D4 and OOCEA. SwRI is investigating permanent fix.
 - **FP 1886:** DMS Message Merging Functionality Expanded to Remote C2C DMS – SwRI proposed a solution at 5/22/2012 CMB using RCA, solution was approved. Likely to be released after R6.0.
 - **FP 1685:** Inter-District TVT Requires Speed Limit in C2C Data – If a TSS link from C2C reports 0 speeds, an associated TVT link will not report since speed limits are unknown for C2C TSS Links. No action
 - **FP 1319:** ASCII values for accented Spanish vowel characters do not translate via C2C – No action
 - C2C Test Environment – included in new 511 scope
 - New/other issues?

- AVL-RR mobile device reconnection issue
 - Batch processing functionality approved at 5/22/2012 CMB; FIFO functionality could also be added at minimal effort
- Recommendation for FP 101 and 1526: zero speed and occupancy
 - Volume weighted averaging and tossing out zero speeds in creating alerts. This is pending an analysis task using D5 archive data. Clay Packard will provide the results to a future CMB and future SSUG meeting; will likely propose a vote on the solution at a future CMB if the analysis confirms the solution effects and demonstrates that the users' needs are met
 - Comments?
- SunGuide R6.0 GUI Discussion
 - Ideas presented at 5/22/2012 CMB
- Adding additional tier to User Permissions per highway, county, city
 - Jason has asked for permission groups to specific subsets of signs.
 - Mark suggests making groups work properly, not just behave like a template, but if group is changed, users within that group are affected (this has already been added to the footprint)
- ODS – TVT report/data usage and FP 1589 redundant records
 - Clay Packard to lead discussion
