<b>Clay Packard</b>	Clay will get cost requested for FP 1634: Populate contact phone numbers if contact is already defined in EM.	Clay emailed about these issues on 11/22/2011 – they are possibly covered by Database ID’s enhancement approved at CMB on 11/15.  Cost estimate was requested again on 1/26/2012 to be provided prior to CMB in February.  This has been approved and implemented and will be released in 6.0. Action Item is closed.
<b>John Hope</b>	John to draft SSUG Charter for review.	John sent out Draft SSUG Charter on 7/11/2012. Received comments via a SunGuide website forum.  Document was finalized on 8/20/2012 and submitted to Arun for comment and to present to the CMB.
<b>Jason Summerfield</b>	Jason will investigate old discussions on the topic of FP 101 and 1526: zero speed and occupancy.	Old discussions centered on how certain reported values should be considered invalid.  FDOT CO performed a study on using a combination of volume-weighted speeds averaging and filtering out zero and extremely low volume speeds.  Study and concept was presented and voted on at 8/15/2012 CMB meeting. Item passed.

<b>All Districts</b>	Districts will send ideas to Clay Packard for making user permissions for intelligent.	Ideas were collected via a SunGuide website forum. Action Item is closed.

<b>Clay Packard</b>	Clay will come up with a concept for FP 1701 (expanding user/device permissions) based on district's feedback and additional research.	SwRI was asked to provide implementation options and costs. SwRI presented options at 8/15/2012 CMB meeting.  This item will be discussed today.
<b>John Hope</b>	John will coordinate a meeting to discuss R6.0 GUI changes and provide outline of changes and ideas prior to meeting.	FDOT CO received no specific/additional comments from Districts. The plan is to break up this enhancement into a design and then implementation phase. During the design phase, there will be multiple reviews split up into multiple subsystems. SSUG members are encouraged to support the process through their District channels to provide input and comments during design reviews and, as always, provide comments through SSUG as well.  Action Item is closed.
<b>FDOT CO</b>	CO to ask districts how is archived TvT data being used, which would provide justification for whether or not the software change to ODS is needed.	No feedback received.

## Current Topics

- C2C Reliability
  - Restarts are frequent throughout the state, more so in some districts than others
  - Open C2C Tickets
    - **FP 2209:** TvT Reporting Zero Speeds when Valid TSS Provided via C2C – SwRI provided a patch for OOCEA and issue appears to be resolved
    - **FP 2167:** C2C Disconnect Handling – Enhancement to not purge all data upon momentary disconnection. SwRI investigating.
    - **FP 2121:** Chronic C2C Disconnections – SwRI provided a patch for OOCEA and issues appear to be resolved
    - **FP 2073:** Generate TSS-like alerts from C2C data sources – May be a large effort to implement. SwRI investigating.

- **FP 2047:** C2C Provider does not receive networkData – Work around is in place for D4 and OOCEA. SwRI is investigating permanent fix.
- **FP 1886:** DMS Message Merging Functionality Expanded to Remote C2C DMS – SwRI proposed a solution at 5/22/2012 CMB using RCA, solution was approved. Likely to be released after R6.0.
- **FP 1685:** Inter-District TVT Requires Speed Limit in C2C Data – If a TSS link from C2C reports 0 speeds, an associated TVT link will not report since speed limits are unknown for C2C TSS Links. No action
- **FP 1319:** ASCII values for accented Spanish vowel characters do not translate via C2C – No action
  - New/other issues?
- Expanded User/Device Permissions
  - SwRI provided two options. Option 1: \$125k and Option 2: \$250k
  - See attached diagram that describes the differences between the two options
