*John Hope was nominated and voted unanimously*
- Brian – FP 1055: Discuss Excel Template and solicit feedback, buy-in, or any possible concerns.  
*will affect all reports when using the excel generation  
will align up as table able to be used for analysis.  
available on SunGuide project website in the Reports Repository as Detector Data Quality Assessment report*
- Arun or Clay – SunGuide 6.0: scope/schedule  
*schedule not final, expected early 2013  
scope to include SQL Server, Color DMS, AVI-TVT algorithm, Scheduling (TVT and CCTV actions).*
- C2C discussion – feedback from users – possible enhancement/ ideas to improve robustness.  
*Mark: restarts every day, sometimes multiple times per day; connected to FL-ATIS, D4, and MDX. FL-ATIS restarts happens the most.  
D2 only connected to FL-ATIS, connections issues, but hard to tell if it's local or on FL-ATIS side. Restarting web services usually clears things up.  
D1 is not having any issues with C2C, they are connected to FL-ATIS and Lee County.  
D2 has his C2C web services (IIS application pools) auto-restarted twice daily 10am & 10pm.  
Neena said FL-ATIS and D4 auto-recycles as well.  
D5 has same problem, if you restart subsystem, they do not populate to FL-ATIS until you restart C2C – quite frequently – end up taking down OOCEA TVT, DMS, or all devices. Doesn't sync back up until we restart C2C, and causes problems with floodgates. Restarting web services in IIS will take down floodgates then requires additional restarts until floodgates work.  
AI: Clay to report status of C2C improvement*
- Clay/Ron/Derek – Video Switching IPVideoDevices.xml configuration file support policy update – we are anticipating support for H.264 and will be providing support from experience both at SwRI and at TERL to provide updates to this configuration/compatibility file. Please be aware of this when you deploy new video switching devices and contact SunGuide support for help with this.

- Clay – DataGuard formal support: This is deferred for now due to SQL migration activity; however, this concept and support should be included in the SQL Server migration scope. Clustering document is being finalized for distribution and publishing on SwRI's website. (done)
