## FMCSA Grant Training Workshop Debrief

Some changes will affect only the FY2011 and newer CVISN grants. Some changes apply to both.

### For both FY07 and FY11 grants:

Need to provide an equipment inventory, on an annual basis, to Mickey Davis with FMCSA. Equipment is defined as real property >\$5000. (Note that we will use the \$5000 value for reporting equipment purchased with CVISN grant funds.) Anything <\$5000 is considered supplies.

Grantee plus all sub-grantees (contractors, vendors, and potentially other state agencies) MUST retain all records for projects in the CVISN grant for three years AFTER the closeout date of the grant.

Although not required in the quarterly reports, there should be an electronic copy of hours/timesheets in the permanent grant folder. Records to be maintained for three years AFTER the closeout date of the grant. This information must be made available to FMCSA upon request.

August 2012 – FMCSA will be changing to submission of SF-270s via iSupplier and no longer using Markview. Training is scheduled for mid-July 2012.

Suggested setting up a generic mailbox that is used for all correspondence and then updating who the mail forwards to, that way the electronic contact information is more likely to stay up to date. [FMCSA\\_CVISNGrants@dot.state.fl.us](mailto:FMCSA_CVISNGrants@dot.state.fl.us).

In preparation for the FY2007 closeout, Florida needs to be prepared to provide a cumulative report of grant activity during the entire period of performance. FMCSA will assess the following items. If any of these are not met, the grantee should explain why they were not in their final report.

- Did the grantee meet all milestones?
- Did the grantee make all purchases?
- Did the grantee fulfill the goals of the grant.

### **NEXT STEPS:**

- Produce and submit equipment inventory to Mickey Davis (due 9/30/2012). Due to Sharon Easley by 9/21/2012
- Begin preparations for grant closeout.

### FY11 grant:

All laptops used by recipients, grantees, and contractors in carrying out the project plan, which contain data pertaining to this agreement, must be encrypted to the same standards utilized by FMCSA.

All projects >\$25,000 that are completed by any entity other than the grantee (i.e. sub-awardees, vendors, contractors) must be filed with the Federal Government. This is due at the end of the month following the month in which the award was made.
