AGENDA ITEMS:

Welcome and Introductions

Marie Tucker welcomed everyone to the meeting and everyone went around the room and introduced themselves.

Current Project updates and/or discussion

Pre-Clearance at Motor Carrier Compliance Weigh Stations

Jerry Bullard reviewed the stats that were provided in the handouts for by-passed and pull-in vehicles as well as the facility open percentages. J. Bullard stated that for each shift the weight inspectors are given the opportunity to turn off PrePass and pull in all trucks. Ken Armstrong asked how many facilities were in the state and J. Bullard stated that there are 20 WIM facilities on the interstate system.

Pre-Clearance at Agriculture Sites

M. Tucker reviewed the stats that were provided in the handouts for DACS since they would not be at the meeting. K. Armstrong asked how many agriculture interdiction stations there were in the state and M. Tucker stated that she would send him that information after the meeting.

Permitting System Enhancements Project

Bryan Hubbard was unable to attend the meeting and did not provide an update. Keith Westphal stated that he knows that the current system modifications were approved and that they are moving forward with and RFQ to do the next round of enhancements. Craig Wilson asked about the status of the WASP scanner software update for the scale facilities. M. Tucker stated that the PO is currently being routed through the approval process.

Automated Permitting System Utilization

Ronnie Martin was unable to attend the meeting and did not provide any data for the meeting handouts. K. Westphal stated that the new system utilization was running at about 70%.

BOL Program

Ken Richards reviewed the numbers from the handouts and stated that it looks like DOR is on target to meet the same numbers as last year. He concluded by stating the Lynn McElroy is working on the write-up for the FY14 grant project for DOR.

E-Credentialing System Usage Stats

D. Helton stated that usage of the electronic credentialing system continues to have some slow and steady progress. There has not been any upgrades to the system since its implementation six or seven years ago and don't foresee that happening for another three to four years when the legacy systems are rebuilt.

VWS Deployments and USDOT Cameras

C. Wilson briefly reviewed some of the possible FY14 grant projects that were originally discussed with Jerry Scott. He then stated that MCSAW is currently working with the vendor in regards to the FY12 grant project to install four USDOT cameras.

Container Number Database

Clay Packard stated that he had a meeting with Paul Clark and M. Tucker and discussed some minor enhancements to complete and then show the database to a small group of users and get some feedback. M. Tucker stated that Troy Thompson had previously mentioned that FHP CVE would be having some training soon and would like to have C. Packard demonstrate the database at that time. T. Thompson stated that he is waiting to hear of this can be put on the agenda and plans to send an email out requesting C. Packard to demo the database.

LPR/PRISM Project (DACS)

M. Tucker stated that Jeff Jordan could not be at the meeting. DACS is currently still working on their protocol so they can implement the system at all sites.

LPR Camera / Container Number Installations

M. Tucker stated that the LPR camera project is complete and the container number installation project is still ongoing and making progress.

Trucking Industry Update

Tisha Keller stated that her big announcement is that Ken Armstrong is the new President/CEO of FTA. She stated that FTA has HB537 on its radar. Federally FTA has EOBR regulations coming down the pipe and drug and alcohol clearinghouse that are currently being monitored. She continued to state that she is working with FHP CVE on the TACT grant. She concluded by stating that the annual trucking day at the capitol is March 27th.

FY14 CVISN Grant

M. Tucker stated that everyone should have received a copy of the FY14 CVISN grant that is due at the end of March. Meetings have been held with everyone that had previously proposed grant projects. If there is anyone else who have projects they would like included in the grant they need to get with M. Tucker ASAP. All draft write-ups are due by the end of February.

CVO Strategic Plan Update

M. Tucker stated that a kick-off meeting has been scheduled so that work can be started on the strategic plan. She followed up by stating that this document is to determine where Florida where move forward with CVO in the next five years. This document does not apply only to CVISN but to CVO as a whole.
