SUBJECT: Window requirements for all vehicles used by public transit providers

This memorandum serves as follow-up communication to public transit providers of the requirements for passenger windows as established by Section 341.051(8)(c), Florida Statutes (F.S.), which became effective July 1, 2024.

Ch. 2024-57, Laws of Florida, amended Section 341.051, F.S. The changes included adding paragraph (8)(c) as follows:

(8) EXTERIOR VEHICLE WRAP, TINTING, PAINT, MARKETING, AND ADVERTISING.

(c) Any new wrap, tinting, paint, medium, or advertisement on the passenger windows of a vehicle used by a public transit provider may not be darker than the legally allowed window tinting requirements provided in s. 316.2954.

As outlined in the Legislative Implementation Update memo to public transit providers, dated July 30, 2024, all new Public Transportation Grant Agreements (PTGAs) with public transit agencies include an additional exhibit that contains specific terms and conditions related to compliance with Section 341.051(8), F.S. Meaning, the requirements in law are also specifically incorporated into these PTGAs. Agencies are reminded that all vehicles used by a public transit provider must be in compliance with the passenger window requirements referred to in Section 341.051(8)(c), F.S.

Please be advised that the Department conducts regular compliance reviews that assess whether vehicles used by a public transit provider meet the requirements of Section 341.051(8), F.S.

Public transit agencies that are found out of compliance may be subject to termination of any active Public Transportation Grant Agreements (PTGAs) with the Department.

The Department appreciates every effort your organization makes to ensure compliance with the law in a consistent and efficient manner.

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
