

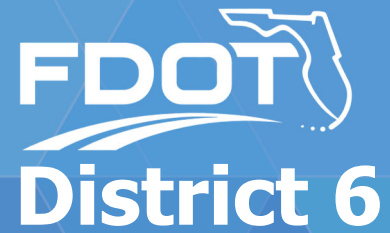

Summary of Projects



DISTRICT SIX PROJECT OVERVIEW

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise continues to invest significant funding for transportation infrastructure in FDOT District Six. Since 2013, nearly \$2.4 billion has been invested in projects to improve the Turnpike System in Miami-Dade County. This includes funding for major capacity improvements along approximately 37 miles of Turnpike Mainline / SR 821 from SW 312th Street / Campbell Drive to I-75, a new interchange at NW 170th Street along Turnpike Mainline / SR 821. Also included are interchange improvements at I-95 / US 441 / SR 826 (Golden Glades) along Turnpike Mainline / SR 91, as well as other safety, maintenance, and operations projects. Major projects are listed in the table below.

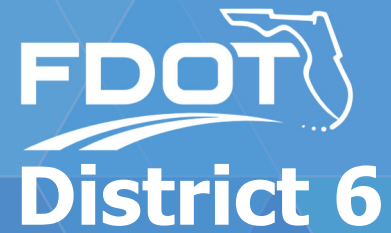

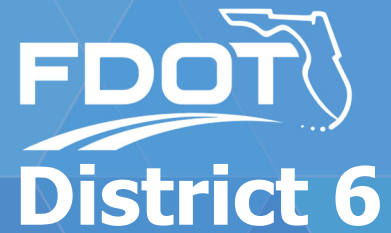

TSM&O Interchange Improvements on Turnpike Mainline / SR 821 at US 1 (MP 0)

FPID: 452112-1

The project provides Transportation Systems Management & Operations (TSM&O) improvements and modifications to the interchange to enhance capacity. Additional turn lanes and intersection improvements, including signalization upgrades, will be made at the ramp terminal connections with US 1.

Snapper Creek Service Plaza General Improvements (MP 19)

FPID: 442620-1

The project upgrades the roadway and parking infrastructure at the Snapper Creek Service Plaza in Miami-Dade County along Turnpike Mainline / SR 821. Work includes milling and resurfacing and concrete pavement rehabilitation of the access roads and parking areas, sidewalk improvements, lighting enhancements, and upgrades to the drainage and guardrail features. The signals at the SW 120th Street intersections will also be replaced.

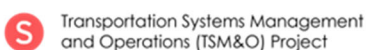
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Interchange Improvements on Turnpike Mainline / SR 91 at I-95 / US 441 / SR 826 (Golden Glades) (MP 0X)

FPID: 437053-1,-2,-3,-4,-5

The project improves operations at the I-95 / US 441 / SR 826 (Golden Glades) interchange. The project includes improved northbound and southbound connections between I-95 and Turnpike Mainline / SR 91. The project also includes ramp improvements from Turnpike Mainline / SR 91 to SR 826 and SR 9A. Additionally, Turnpike Mainline / SR 91 northbound ramps from NW 167th Street and SR 826, and the southbound ramp to NW 167th Street, will be reconstructed. The Enterprise is managing and funding FPID: 437053-5, while other portions of the project (FPID: 437053-1 through -4) are funded by the Enterprise but are being managed by FDOT District 6. This project goes with FDOT District 6 project FPID: 428358-1,-4,-8. Construction of this over \$591 million project began in FY 2024 and the remaining expenditures to complete the project are funded in FY 2026 through FY 2028.

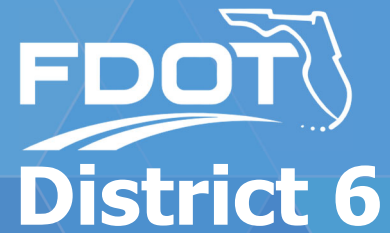

Summary of Projects



Widen Turnpike Mainline / SR 91 from the Golden Glades Plaza (MP 0.4X) to the Miami-Dade / Broward County Line (MP 3.3X)

FPID: 423373-5

The project widens a segment of Turnpike Mainline / SR 91 from the Golden Glades Plaza to the Miami-Dade/Broward County Line. The widening will increase the number of travel lanes from six to eight. Work includes pavement widening, milling and resurfacing, electronic toll collection gantry replacement, and bridge widening and replacement.

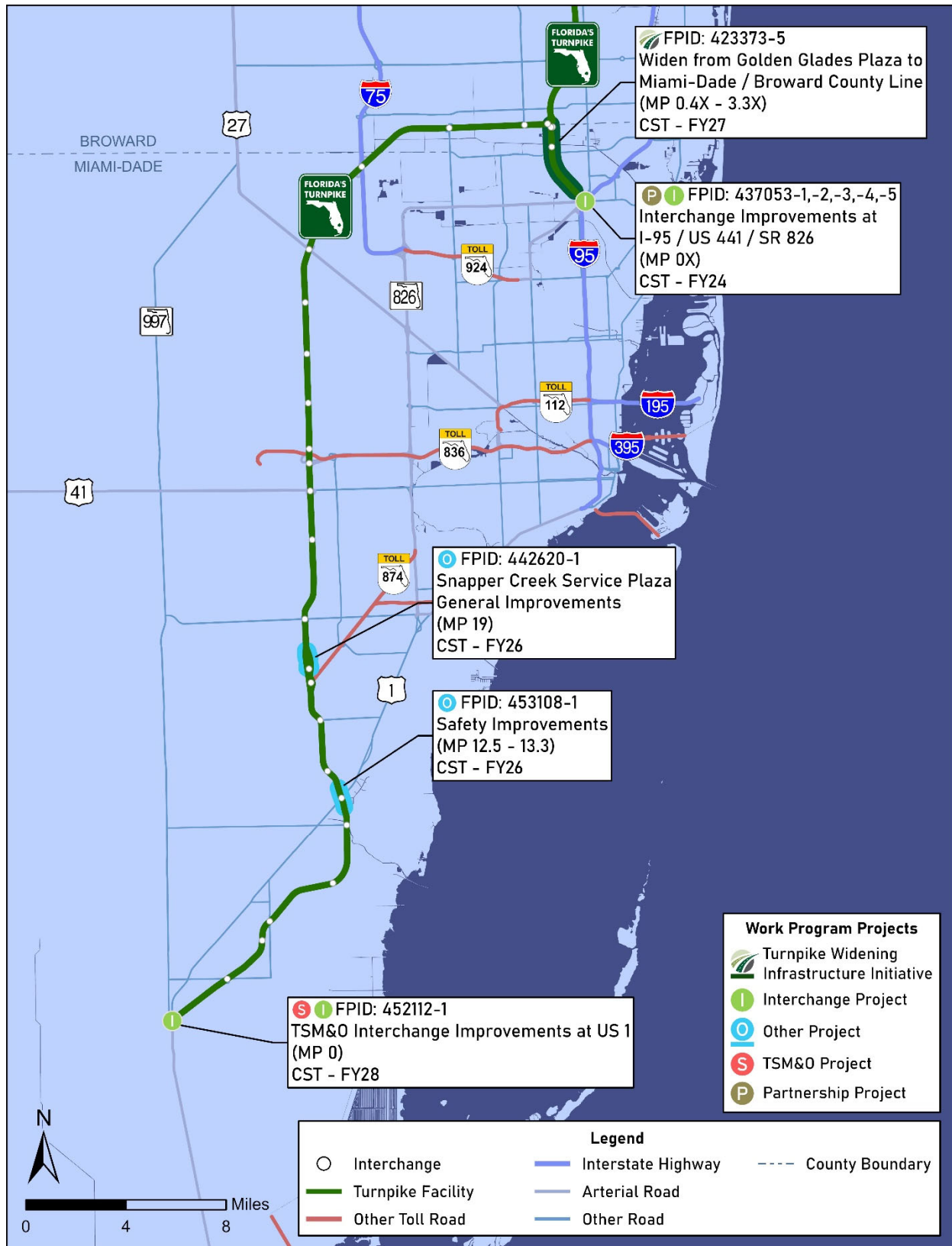
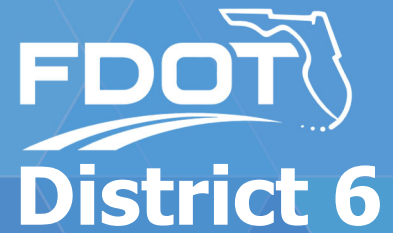

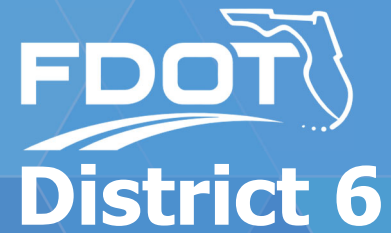
