Summary of Projects



Overview

The First Coast Expressway / SR 23 is a 46-mile, four-lane, limited access toll facility from I-95 in St Johns County to I-10 in Duval County. Constructed in phases, the facility is a partnership between FDOT District Two and Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (the Enterprise), with a total cost of approximately \$2 billion. FDOT District Two is responsible for planning, designing, and constructing the facility, while the Enterprise owns, operates, and maintains the facility once it is open to traffic. Currently under construction are two roadway segments from I-95 to SR 16, totaling \$525 million in project costs.

In FY 2027 through FY 2031, over \$4 million in Enterprise funding is programmed for a resurfacing project along First Coast Expressway / SR 23. This amount includes the phases referenced below:
